Catch up Premium

The Government provided schools with Catch Up premium during the academic year 2020-21, in order to help schools support those children who had fallen behind during the COVID 19 pandemic.

At Garstang Community Primary School, we received £16, 480 for the academic year.

Following target setting meetings, staff identified those pupils for whom extra support was needed in order for them to make up lost learning. This support was a combination of 1-1, small group and in class support. The funding was used to support the identified pupils in the following ways:

- To fund additional Teaching Assistant hours to support children using a range of bought in intervention programmes
- To fund additional Teacher hours for tailored small group and 1-1 interventions
- To access training and resources to support interventions (Bounce back phonics, Rising Stars Maths, Power of 2, Cogmed, Sound Learning)

Impact of the funding will be evaluated through data (NFER test data and teacher assessment)
