- Air travel including old planes.
- Chinese New Year.

In our Phonic sessions at 9-9.30 we will be beginning Phase 3 sounds and learning to read and **spell** Phase 2 tricky words.

In Maths we will be:

- Alive in 5 (2 weeks)

- Growing 6, 7, 8 (2 weeks)
- Length, Height and Time (1 week)

In **Science** we will be focusing on different materials.

- Identifying wood, plastic, glass and metal.

In Geography we will be focusing on:

In History we will be focusing on:
