Skills to practise at home:

Reading: Read with an adult every day. Please keep a track in your Reading Record.

Spelling: Practise Year 3 and 4 spellings (see spelling sheet)

Weekly spelling on Spelling Shed.

Maths: Diagnostic questions and practise your times tables to 12 x 12



Maths:

Count forwards and backwards in steps of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1000 from zero. Count backwards through zero into negative numbers in 1s and larger steps.

Learn by heart times tables and division facts up to 12 x 12

Add and subtract numbers mentally with increasingly large numbers

Add and subtract 4 digit numbers using formal methods

Add and subtract amounts of money to calculate change

Convert between digital, analogue and 24hr clock. Convert hours to minutes, minutes to seconds, years to months and weeks to days

Count up and down in hundredths

Solve simple measure and money problems with fractions and decimals to 2dp

Convert between units of measure e.g. cms to ms, kgs to gs

Round any numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000

Recognise Roman numerals to 100
