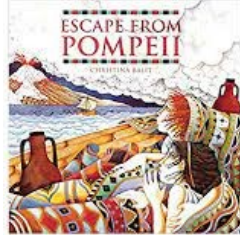


In English we will be reading and enjoying the text 'Escape From Pompeii' by Christina Balit. The children will write a diary entry as one of the characters in the story, thinking about how they would feel as Vesuvius erupts. They will also write their own version of the story describing escaping from Pompeii from the viewpoint of a new character.



In RE we will be studying Christianity with a focus on God. We will continue to explore how we should live our lives but will focus our learning on how and why Christians might use the Bible. Children will be encouraged to explore different Christian beliefs about the Bible as the word of God.

In Maths, we will start our work on addition and subtraction. We will look at strategies that can be used to add/subtract two 4-digit numbers as well as recognising which methods are more efficient than others in given situations. We will also be continuing to explore multiplication and division, looking at multiplying and dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by 1 digit. Please keep practising all the times tables at home 0×0 to 12×12 .

Our PE days are: Wednesday and Thursday - PE kits must be worn to school on these days.

Our sports will be: Invasion games and outdoor and adventurous team games .
